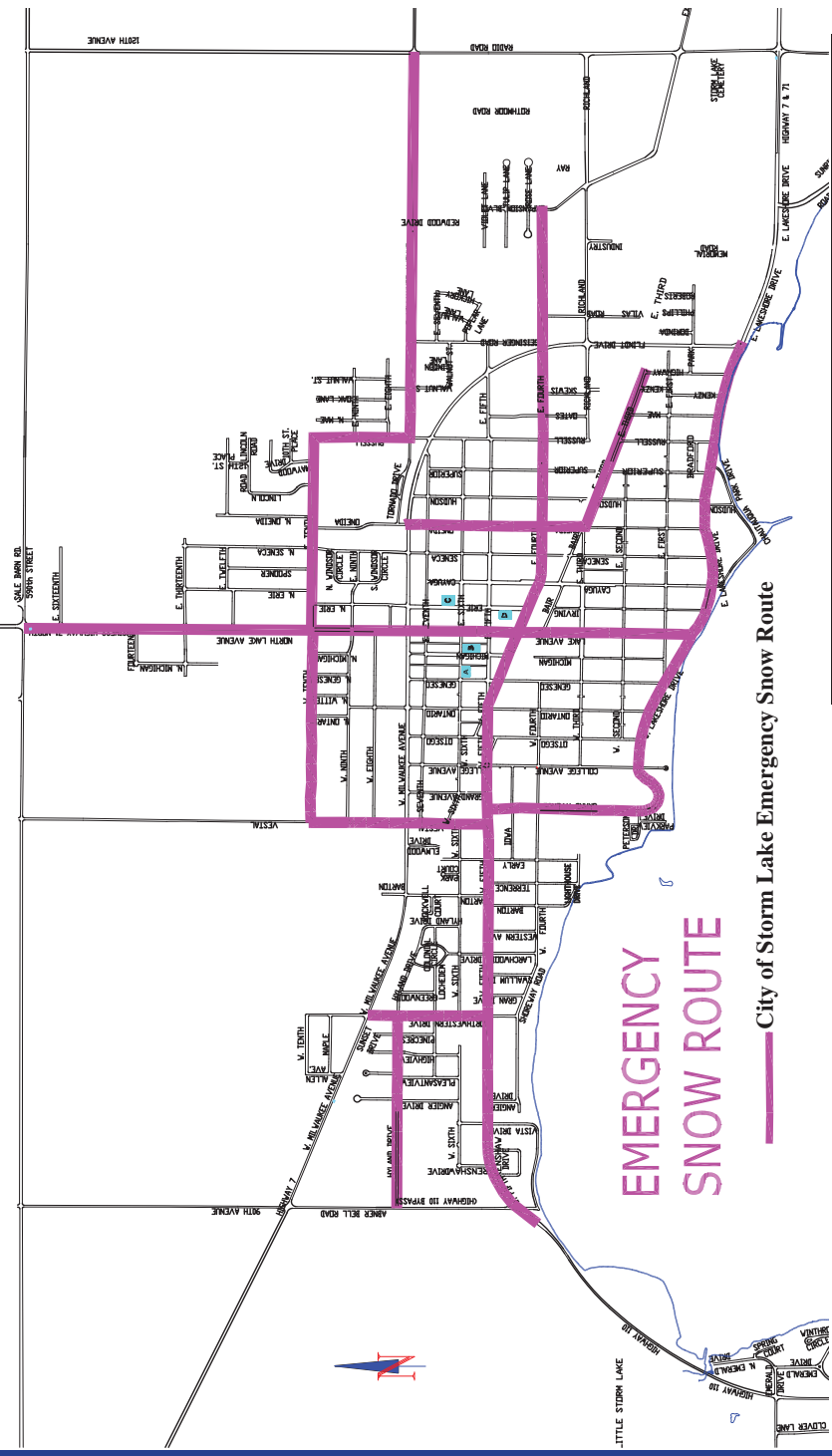


EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES

Storm Lake Snow Ordinance

New Snow Ordinance

In the Spring of 2008 the City of Storm Lake revised its snow ordinance. This brochure provides a background of those new regulations and what residents need to do to comply with the new ordinance.

BASIC REGULATIONS

The new ordinance allows for parking of vehicles and trailers on City Streets throughout the year with the following exceptions:

- Parking is not allowed on streets designated as no parking routes by City Code (these streets are signed “No Parking” and parking is not allowed under any circumstance)
- Parking is not allowed on City streets during a **Declared Snow Emergency** between the following hours:

Residential Streets between the hours of 10:00PM and 6:00AM

Central Business District between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM

DOWNTOWN PARKING

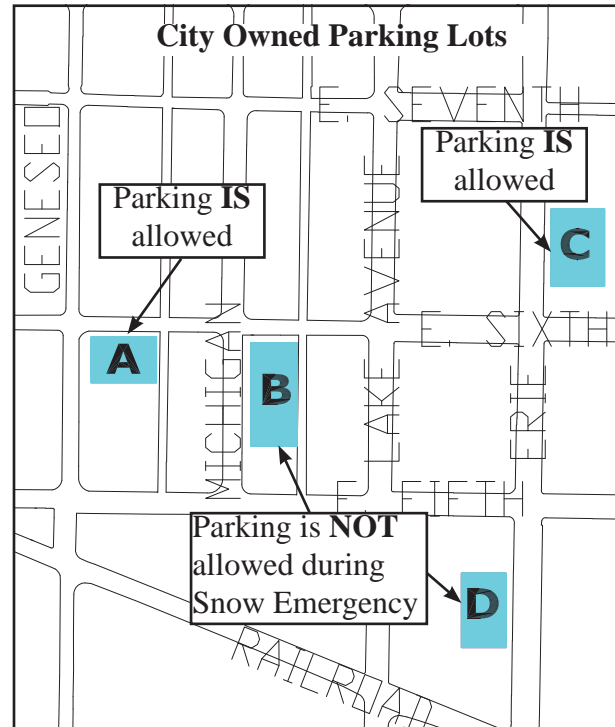
Parking in the Central Business District or downtown is prohibited between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM during a declared Snow Emergency.

In addition, during a declared Snow Emergency parking is only allowed in two of the four city owned downtown parking lots. These two parking lots are:

The parking lot located at the corner of Geneseo and West 6th Street - this lot is designated as **Lot A** on the following map.

The parking lot located on the east side of the 700 block of Erie Street - this lot is designated as **Lot C** on the following map.

Parking during a snow emergency in lots B and D is not allowed.



NOTIFICATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY

Citizens and visitors can find out about a declared Snow Emergency in one of the following ways:

- Notification will be given to all local and regional media for dissemination to the general public.
- A web site with up to date information has been set up to inform citizens and visitors of issues involving declared Snow Emergencies. That web site is www.213snow.com. Links to the web page are also provided from the City of Storm Lake web page at www.stormlake.org.
- A telephone hot line has been set up at 712-213-SNOW (7669). This hot line will provide citizens and visitors

with a notification message regarding the current status of a declared Snow Emergency within the City of Storm Lake.

- Citizens can sign up on the Snow Emergency web site (www.213snow.com) for e-mail alerts regarding any new declarations.


To help make it easier to remember this hot line number and web page the city is offering residents a limited number of magnets that contain the hot line number and web page. Please stop by City Hall to pick up a magnet if you need one.

PENALTY & VIOLATION

As in the past, vehicles that are in violation of this ordinance may be fined and/or towed to make room for the City of Storm Lake to remove snow from the streets in a safe and timely manner.

Vehicles that are towed will be stored in the City of Storm Lake impound lot and can be claimed at the Storm Lake Public Safety Department, located at 401 East Milwaukee Ave., during normal business hours (M-F 8AM-10PM).
