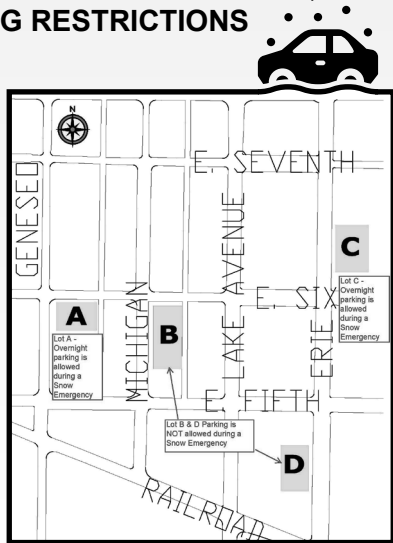
SNOW REMOVAL

The City appreciates the cooperation of the citizens and property owners in helping remove snow from sidewalks and driveways within 72 hours of a snow fall. NEVER push snow into the street or alley! DURING A DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCY, THE FOLLOWING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ARE IN PLACE:

- Parking is NOT ALLOWED on streets:
 - In residential areas from 10 pm-6 am
 - In the Central Business District from 2 am-6 am
- Parking is NOT ALLOWED in downtown public parking lots designated as Lot B and Lot D
- Overnight parking IS ALLOWED in downtown public parking lots designated as Lot A and Lot C
