

The West 5th Street Overlay Project will consist of the overlay of West 5th Street from Lake Avenue west to Vista Drive. As a way of keeping citizens and visitors informed about the project, the City has developed a project blog for the page: www.stormlake.org/w5thproject.

The blog will be updated on a regular basis by City staff. Because part of the project is funded with State funds, the City will be required to bring all intersections of sidewalks to the most current ADA (American Disability Act) standards which will include some modifications to the grade of the sidewalks, repair of curb deterioration, and other issues that are not up to code. UPDATE: Utility Bill Rate Changes Effective July 1, 2014

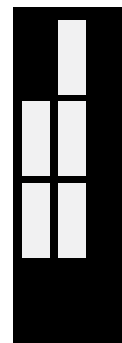

These rates will be effective on July 1, 2014. The rate increases will be on your bill for the first time with the bills sent out at the end of July. Those bills are due and payable on August 15, 2014. Water and sewer charges will vary depending on usage. Commercial Storm Water charges are based on total impervious surface area divided by 2,750 square feet (1 ERU) times the ERU charge of \$4.
