## Library Events

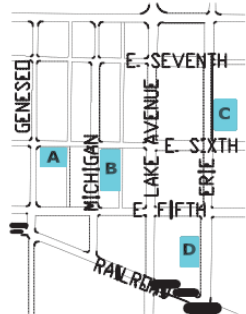
### What's Happening at the Library:

## Snow Emergency Parking Restrictions

During a declared snow emergency, the following parking restrictions are in place:

- Parking is NOT ALLOWED on streets in residential areas of Storm Lake between the hours of 10 PM and 6 AM
- Parking is NOT ALLOWED on streets in the Central Business District between the hours of 2 AM and 6 AM
- Parking is NOT ALLOWED in downtown public parking lots designated as Lot B and Lot D
- Overnight parking in downtown public parking lots shows as Lot A and Lot C is allowed during snow emergencies
