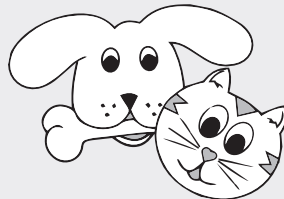
Garbage Storage and Collection

Garbage Storage and Collection is addressed in Section 3-1 of the Storm Lake City Code. The purpose of this chapter is to eliminate unhealthy, unsanitary, and unsightly conditions in the City caused by deposits and accumulation of garbage and to regulate the collection. Garbage and recyclable materials stored outdoors shall be kept in cans and covered. No garbage or recyclable materials shall accumulate on properties. Any violation to this chapter may constitute a Municipal infraction.

For Pet-Owners

Please remember to pick up your pet's feces and dispose of it properly in a garbage container. Picking up after your pet is a way to protect the environment and the lake, and keep Storm Lake beautiful.

All pets are required to be in a kennel, fenced in a yard, or on a leash.

All dogs and cats within the City are required to be registered annually. Registration can be done at your family vet or at the Storm Lake Public Safety Department. (401 East Milwaukee St.)
