FALL DEBRIS DISPOSE

It's almost autumn which means the leaves will be falling soon. The City of Storm Lake asks citizens not to dump anything in ditches, waterways, or the street as you clean up your yard. Twigs, brush debris, leaves, and cut grass washes off into public areas when it rains. This leads to clogs in storm water pipes and eventually can contaminate the lake with pesticides and animal feces. Try composting your yard waste or taking it to the Harold Rowley Recycling Center.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The City of Storm Lake will flush hydrants starting September 17th for approximately two weeks. During the process, customers should check their water supply in the morning from the cold water faucets nearest their water meter. If you notice discoloration, flush your household system for 5-7 minutes from the cold water faucet nearest the water meter. If the discoloration continues, call the City of Storm Lake at 732-8020. When calling, provide your location and the time of discoloration. Flushing will occur between **11 pm and 7 am** during the dates mentioned above. For details, visit www.stormlake.org/hydrant.
