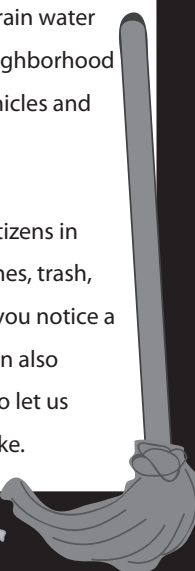

Storm Water Tip of the Month

With the potential for fall rains now is a great time to help the environment and your neighborhood by picking up trash and cleaning up grass and debris in the streets outside of your home. Trash and debris can get carried into the storm water intakes on the streets and plug them so that rain water backs up in the streets causing neighborhood street flooding and damage to vehicles and private property.

The City appreciates the help of citizens in keeping Storm Drains free of branches, trash, and grass clippings and leaves. If you notice a storm drain that is plugged you can also contact the City at 712-732-8002 to let us know so we can clean out the intake.
