CITY CONNECTIONS- Garbage Storage & Collection

Garbage Storage and Collection is addressed in Section 3-1 of the Storm Lake City Code. The purpose of this chapter is to eliminate unhealthy, unsanitary, and unsightly conditions in the City caused by deposits and accumulation of garbage and to regulate the collection. Garbage and recyclable materials stored outdoors shall be kept in cans and covered.


