

Hydrant Flushing...

The City of Storm Lake will hold a hydrant flush during the month of April. Find the flushing date on the City's website at www.stormlake.org/hydrant or check the site's New section.

Quick Tips: If residents notice dirty or rusty looking water they should flush their lines by running the COLD water faucet nearest the water meter for 5-10 minutes.



SUMP PUMP INFORMATION City Ordinance 3-2-5 (B) requires sump pumps to outlet to the outside of the house and not into the sanitary sewer system (floor drains, sinks, etc.). Sump pumps that outlet to the sanitary sewer system cause added flow to the sanitary system which can cause sewer backups in your home and the homes of your neighbors.

Sidewalk Inspection Program...

Inspections of sidewalks within the city shall be done at least once four (4) years with zones one (1) and two (2) being inspected this year starting in April. These inspections include identification of any violations or deficiencies in the sidewalk. Inspectors record these deficiencies by writing an inspection report and highlighting the violations on the sidewalk with paint. VOTE AT HOME

The World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 a pandemic, President Donald Trump has declared COVID-19 a national emergency and Governor Kim Reynolds has signed a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency amid COVID-19 cases in Iowa. With that in mind, the Buena Vista County Auditor's Office has made the decision to conduct the June 2, 2020 Primary Election essentially as a vote by mail election. We are encouraging all Buena Vista County voters to request an absentee ballot and to cast their ballot in the comfort and security of their own homes. We ask that you protect yourself and our Precinct Election Officials by simply completing an Absentee Ballot Request Form and returning it to Buena Vista County Auditor, P O Box 220, Storm Lake, IA 50588. (A request form must be received in our office by 5:00 p.m. on May 22nd.) To participate in the Primary Election, you are required to declare membership with the Democratic or Republican Party. You may declare your party affiliation by simply checking the appropriate box on the Absentee Ballot Request Form. There will only be two voting locations for the Primary Election, so we are asking that you refrain from using these facilities unless you are unregistered or have some other voter registration issue.

VOTE EN CASA



La Organización Mundial de la Salud ha declarado que el COVID-19 es una pandemia, el presidente Donald Trump ha declarado que COVID-19 es una emergencia nacional y la Gobernadora Kim Reynolds ha firmado una Proclamación de Emergencia de Desastre por causa de casos COVID-19 en Iowa. Con esto en mente, La Oficina del Auditor del Condado de Buena Vista ha tomado la decisión de llevar a cabo la Elección Primaria del 2 de junio de 2020 esencialmente como una elección de votar por correo. Nosotros instamos a que todos los votantes del Condado de Buena Vista pidan una boleta de voto ausente y que emitan sus boletas desde la seguridad y la comodidad de sus propias casas. Pedimos que se protejan a sí mismos y a los oficiales de Nuestro Distrito Electoral al simplemente llenar el Formulario de Solicitud de Boleta de Voto Ausente y al devolvérselo a la Auditora del Condado de Buena Vista, P.O. Box 220, Storm Lake, IA 50588 (los formularios de solicitud han de recibirse en nuestra oficina para las 5:00 p.m. el día 22 de mayo). Para participar en la Elección Primaria, se le requiere que declare la membresía con el Partido Demócrata o Republicano. Se puede declarar la afiliación de partido al simplemente marcar la casilla apropiada en el Formulario de Solicitud de Boleta de Voto Ausente. Sólo habrá dos lugares de votación para la elección primaria, así que les pedimos que abstengan de usar estas instalaciones a menos que no esté registrado o que tenga algún otro problema con la inscripción de votante.
