Sump Pump Notice

The City of Storm Lake wants to remind residents and businesses that City Code **REQUIRES** that the sump pumps outlet to the outside of the house and **NOT** into the sanitary sewer system. (Ordinance 3-2-5 (B))



Sump Pumps that outlet to the sanitary sewer system add water to the collection system that can cause backups in your home and your neighbors' homes during rain events.

Community Nuisance Issues

As a responsible resident, please be considerate of others.

By providing covered cans or containers for garbage and recyclables.



Keeping tree limbs no less than eight feet (8') above the surface of any public sidewalk.

Not to allow runoff causing pollution or siltation on the property. Keep our Lake Clean.



Not accumulating trash, junk, or recyclables on your property. Examples are metal, furniture, appliances, garbage, tires, Junk, rock piles or broken concrete.



Grass and Weeds

City code requires trimming of grasses and weeds as follows before they reach a height of eight (8) inches. Any accumulation of dead weeds or grass that are exposed to public view, on any non-farm property also is considered a nuisance. This provision shall not apply to prairies, wetlands, or similar areas of naturalized perennial vegetation which are certified by an Enforcement Officer to not constitute a nuisance.

Please remember to keep grass and weeds cut to avoid a nuisance citation. Please keep grass clippings out of the street to keep them out of the storm sewer.

The City will continue to be Storm Lake Proud by working to mow public open spaces as well as park areas. We encourage the public's cooperation to maintain private properties in the community.



Pets



Please remember to pick up your pet's feces and dispose of it properly in a garbage container. Picking up after your pet is a way to protect the environment and keep Storm Lake beautiful.

All pets are required to be in a kennel, fenced in a yard, or on a leash. All dogs and cats within the City are required to be registered annually at the vet or at the Storm Lake Public Safety Department.
