

Adopt A Storm Water Structure Program

The City of Storm Lake is committed to the beautification and cleanliness of Storm Lake and also committed to the health and safety of the lake. There are a large number of storm water structures located throughout the community which are made available to individuals and business owners to adopt and keep healthy. With this comes many challenges and without volunteers all these items could not be maintained. The City encourages volunteers to help maintain the vision of Storm Lake Proud.

RESPONSIBILITIES for Storm Water Structure Adoption:

City: Assist in educating the adoptor on what is native and what is a weed.
Notify city staff if in need of plant replacement.
Provide signage to acknowledge adoption if the adopter so desires.
Prepare structure for Winter and Spring.
Purchase new plantings if necessary

Adoptor: Remove and dispose of liter and weeds.
Notify City staff of hazardous conditions, problems or concerns.
Visit the site frequently to ensure a clean and healthy environment.
Follow safety procedures when working in city right of way.

STORM WATER STRUCTURES locations:

Along Lakeshore Drive east (11 of them) and west (6 of them) of Radio Road
Lake Avenue from 13th Street to C49
Barton and 4th Street
Spooner Street from 10th Street to 13th Street
Corner of Erie Street and 6th Street (4 corners and 2 on Erie Street)
Erie Street from 6th Street to Milwaukee Avenue
East End of Magnolia Street
Circle Park
