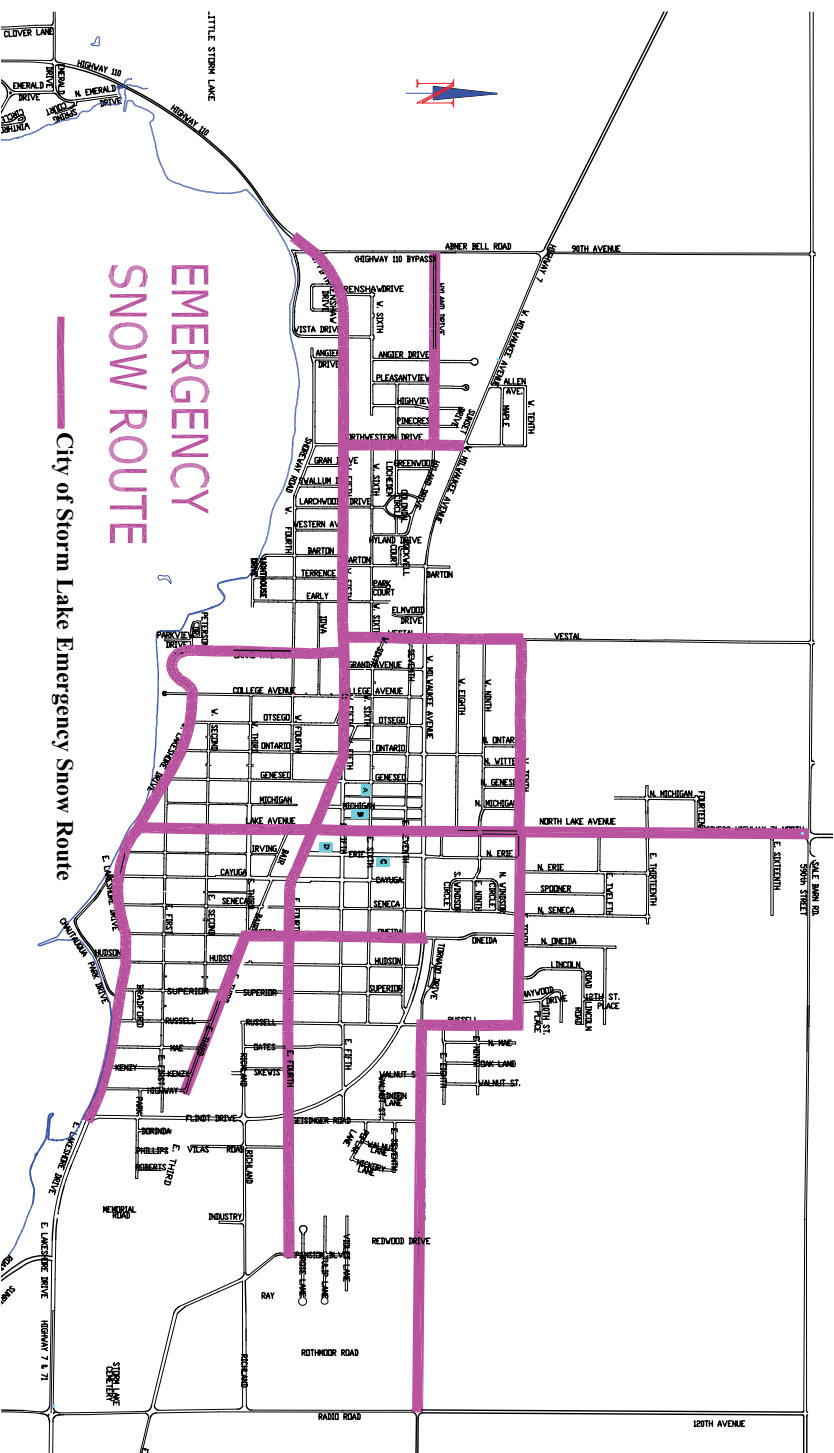

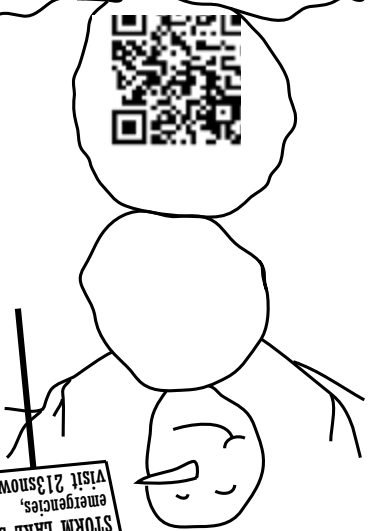
Emergency Snow Routes are the Priority Streets for Snow Removal.

SNOW ORDINANCE

This brochure provides a background of regulations that residents need to be aware of in order to comply with Storm Lake's Snow Ordinance.



Vehicles may be parked on City Streets throughout the year, with the following exceptions:

- Parking is not allowed on streets designated as "no parking routes" by City Code.
- Parking is not allowed on residential streets between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM during a declared snow emergency.
- Parking is not allowed in the Central Business district between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM.



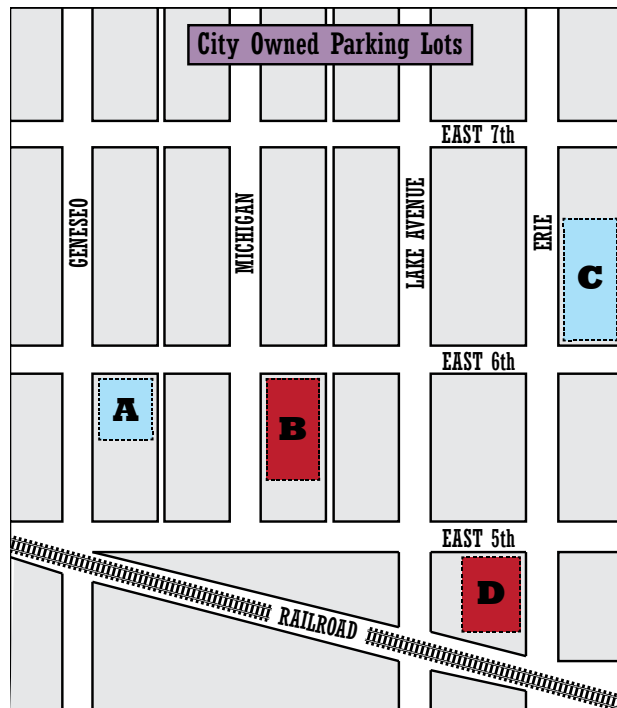
A declared "snow emergency" means that parking is NOT allowed on City streets or in parking lots.

During a declared snow emergency, parking is only allowed in two of the four City-owned downtown parking lots:

- The lot located at the corner of Geneseo and East 6th St. (Lot A)
- The lot located on the east side of the 700 block of Erie St. (Lot C)



Lot A & Lot C: Parking is allowed.
 Lot B & Lot D: Parking not allowed during snow emergency.



NOTIFICATION METHODS OF SNOW EMERGENCY

- Notification will be given to all local and regional media for dissemination to the general public.
- Visit www.213snow.com or www.stormlake.org
- A telephone hotline is available at 712.213.7669. This hotline will provide citizens with a notification message regarding the current status of a declared snow emergency within the City of Storm Lake.
- Sign up on www.213snow.com for email alerts regarding any new emergency declarations.

Penalty & Violation

Vehicles that are in violation may be fined and/or towed to make room for the City to remove snow from the streets in a safe and timely manner.

Towed vehicles will be stored at the City's impound lot and can be claimed at the Storm Lake Public Safety Department, located at 401 E Milwaukee Ave., during normal business hours (M-F 8:00 am-10:00 pm).
